

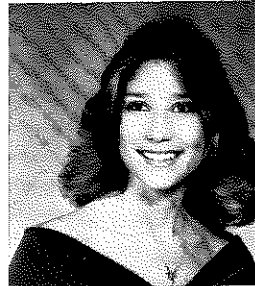

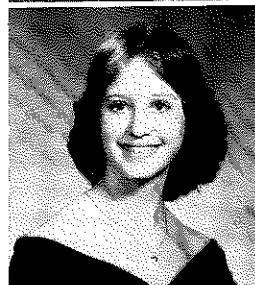

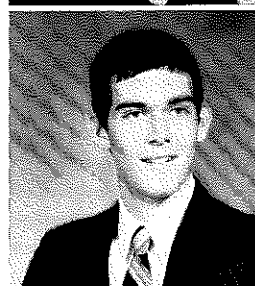

We would like to thank many of the area merchants who were kind

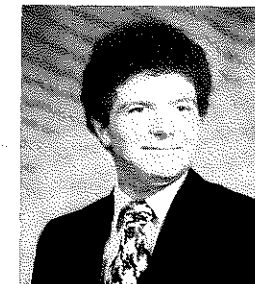

While we've done a lot of comparisons with a sense of responsibility and respect for you, our readers, it's all been done in fun. ENJOY!!!

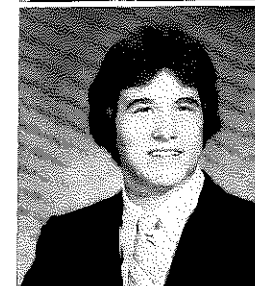
