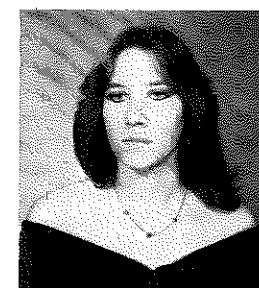
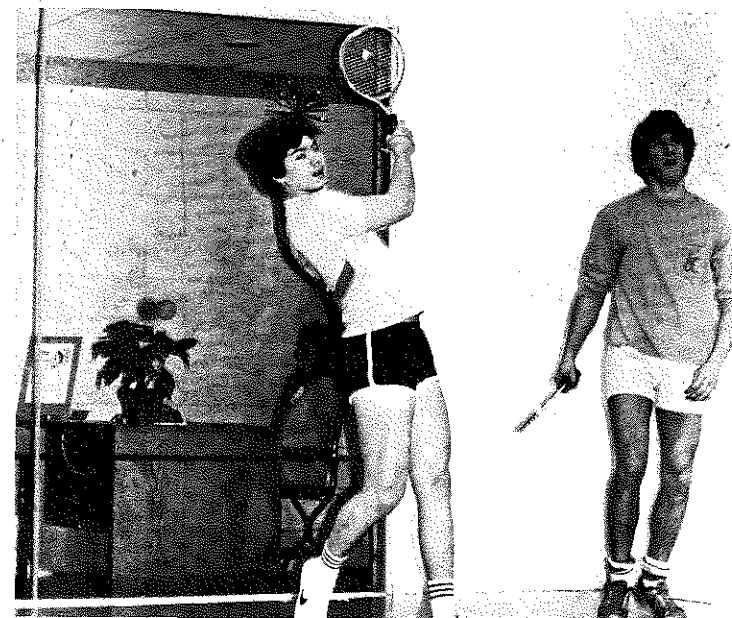
Odyssey's Best: Racquet Club

Worst local club was Perring which featured only two courts, poor service, and walls which sounded like the building was coming down when struck by the ball.



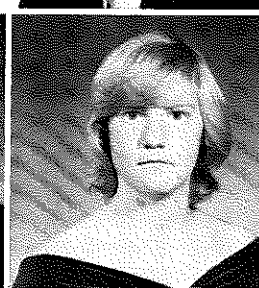
