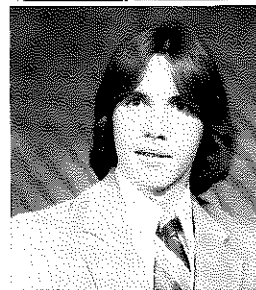

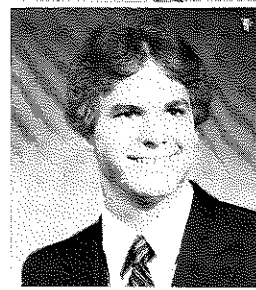

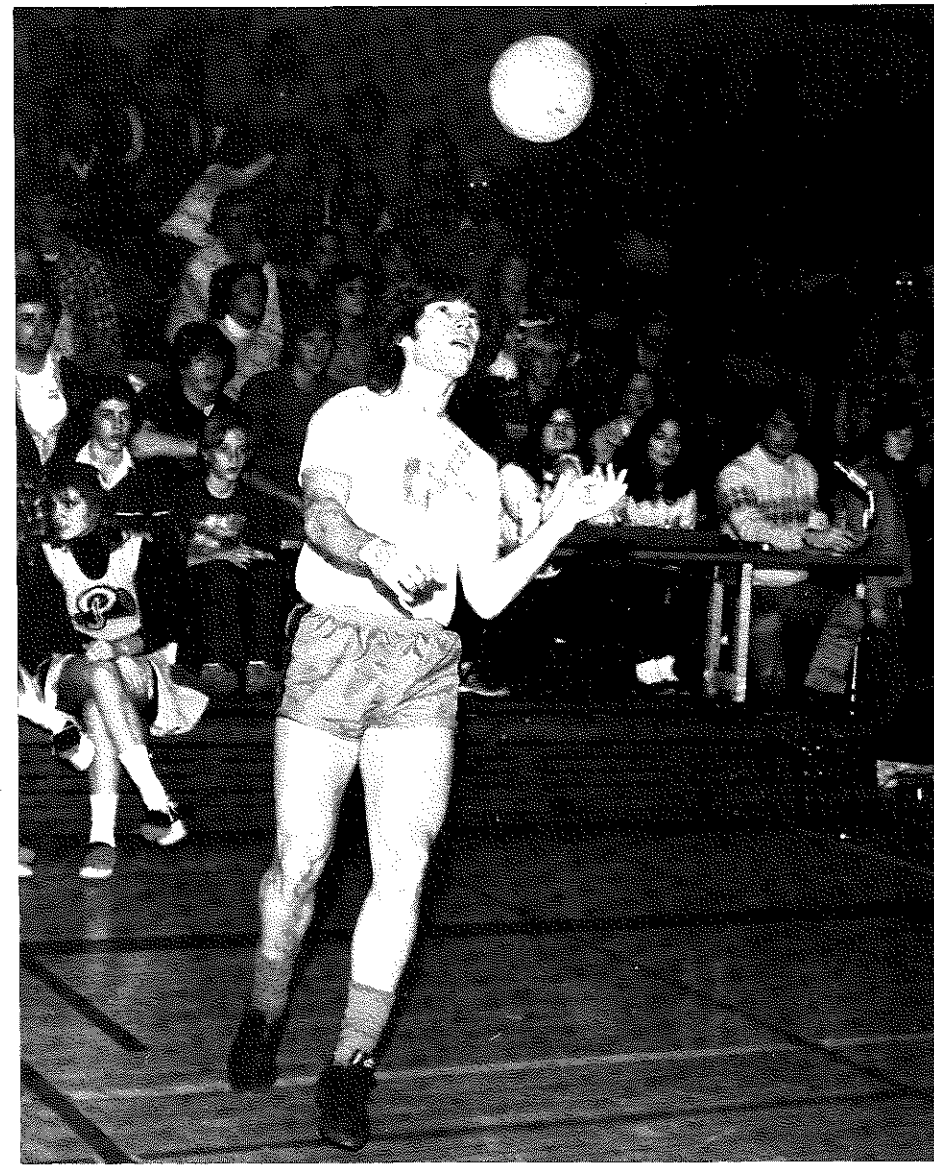
Odyssey's Best: Sports Event
