## Senior Elective Course

With more and more required

The very special communication that resulted in the ERP course between kids and students like Dave Flinkman is part of the magic of one of Parkville's favorite senior electives.



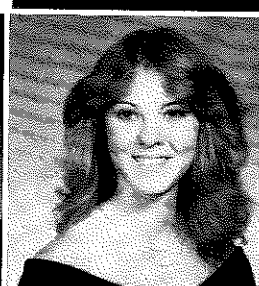
