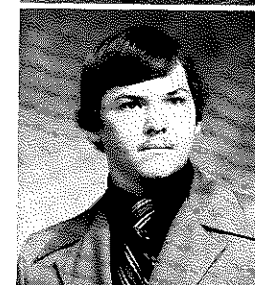
Worst costume goes collectively to those decreasing number of unspirited students who refuse to dress up and take part in the fun. Hopefully, they're a dying breed.



Stalking the halls of Parkville all day was senior Rick McLain who was one of the many spirited members of the senior class.



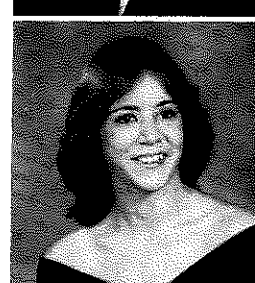
