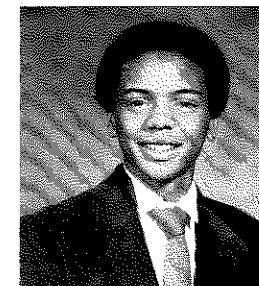
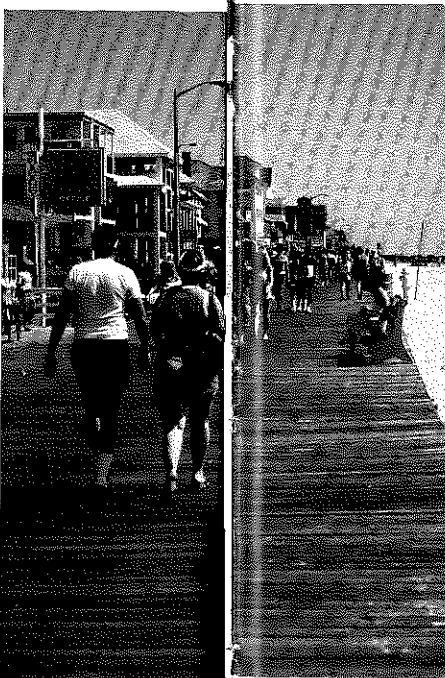
Just about everything is there — condominiums, sand, bay, ocean, bars, shopping centers, "beverage" stores, sea gulls, guys, girls, etc.

As far as someplace to stay during senior week: it hardly matters as long as you're down there with your friends celebrating graduation and having the time of your life.

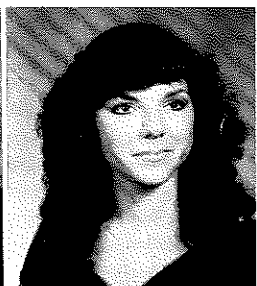
The worst place to stay is in any vehicle with four wheels or on the beach where you can get run over by a vehicle with four wheels!

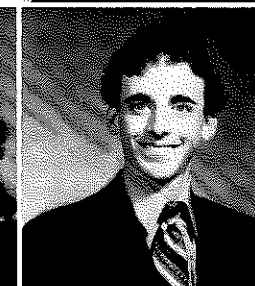
