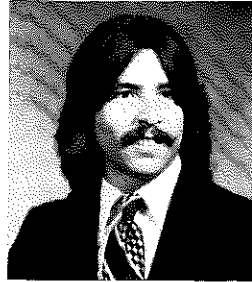

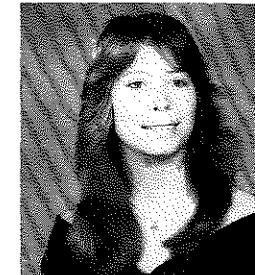
The White Marsh arcade features a wide variety of games in a clean, well-lit atmosphere. The use of tokens
