Together musically since 1970, the group has long been a local favorite. They were familiar to most local fans

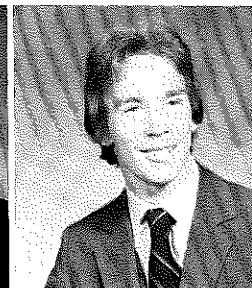
