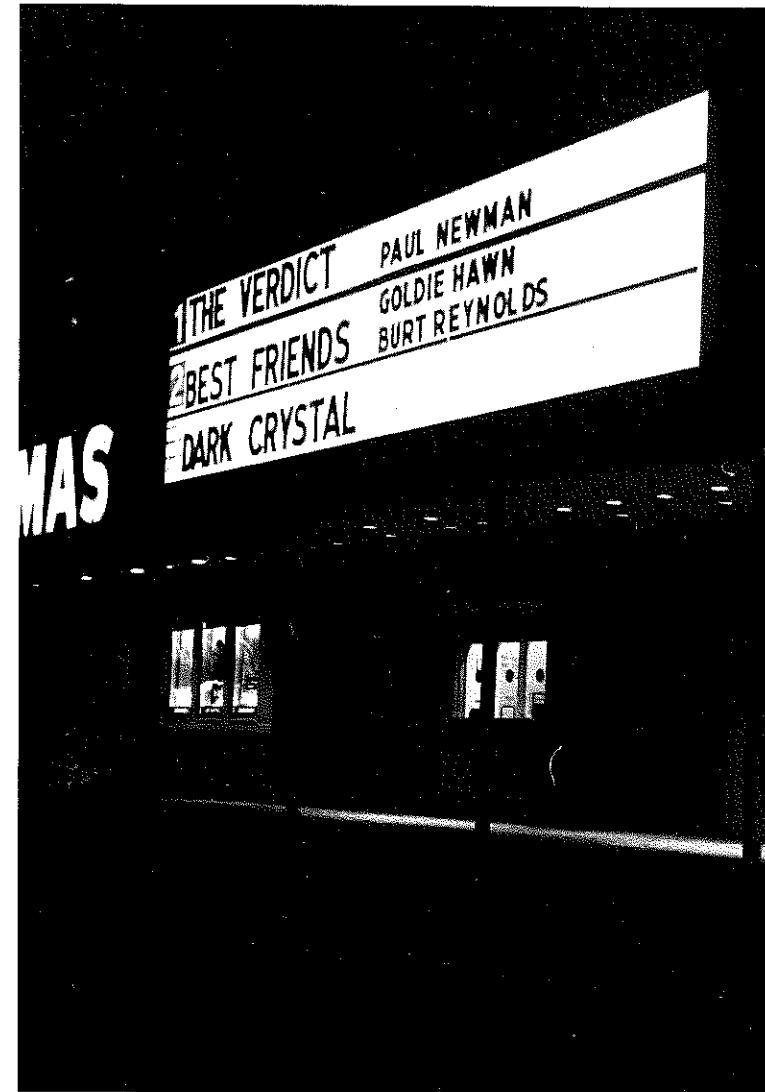
A variety of attractive features recommends Timonium. These include plenty of parking, very comfortable seats, three different theatres with a variety of films, and fresh snacks. Most importantly is the construction of the theatres which include properly angled

seats which give a good view from almost anywhere in the theatre.

Worst place to see a film is in any of the movie houses at Golden Ring Mall. Biggest complaint from students we talked to is the seating. Incredibly, the theatres were built without a properly leveled floor and watching a film here is like watching one in a classroom. Hassles about not being allowed to buy tickets ahead of time and a gestapo like enforcement of the R rating restrictions are common complaints against Golden Ring.



Incredibly poor seating arrangements, overzealous enforcement of the R rating policy, and absurd ticket buying procedures helped make the Movies at Golden Ring Mall *Odyssey's* worst.



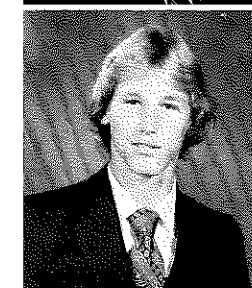
Timonium Cinemas, with three movie houses, offered film fans a variety of pictures and allowed them to enjoy the movie in comfortable seats.

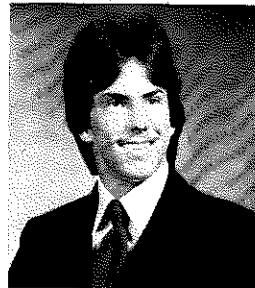

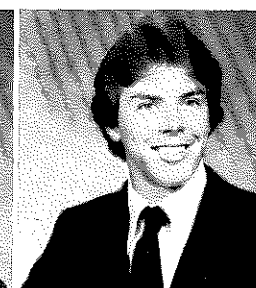

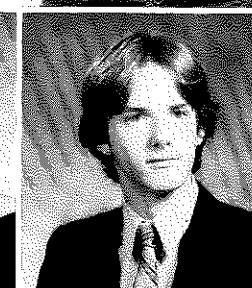
