Tyler's, a clothing store located in the North Plaza Mall, is our choice as the area's best place to buy the latest fashions.

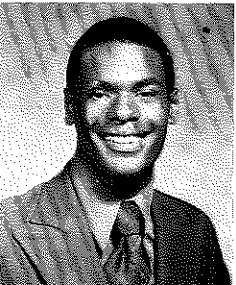

Although the store is built around an obvious western motif, Tyler's does feature a

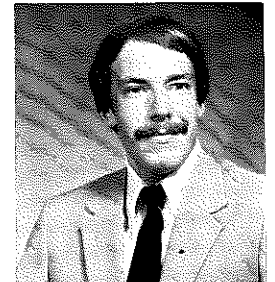
variety of clothing styles. Students can find almost any "look" from preppy to sporty, to western, to dress up.
