Hale's had a wide variety of seafood in addition to crabs which were available nearly year round.

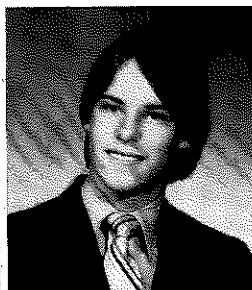
## Odyssey's Best: Crab House

What's good, blue, and liked by just about everyone? No, not Smurfs — Chesapeake Bay Blue Crabs. We live in one of the nation's largest crab producing areas and people around here take their crabs very seriously. Crabs were plentiful in 1982 and prices varied from a low \$2.99 for a dozen live crabs at roadside stands to nearly \$30 for steamed jumbos.

Best local place to get this Maryland delicacy is Hale's Seafood located at Oakleigh and Taylor Avenues. Hale's offers a wide selection of crab

sizes and prices and prepares them year round in their own steaming room. Even during the winter, you can get freshly steamed crabs which are prepared at Hale's after being flown in from Florida or Louisiana.

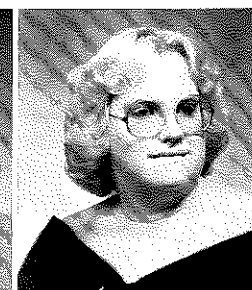
